BEFORE YOU GO

- Get your dog up-to-date with vaccines.
- Check rules and regulations at your campsite.
- Buy all necessary dog camping gear.
- Plan a short trip to get your dog used to camping.

AT THE CAMPSITE

- Never leave your dog unattended.
- Provide entertainment with toys & treats.
- Make sure your dog has the opportunity to hydrate regularly.
- Keep your dog safe with a campsite dog hitching system.

WHEN YOU ARE OUT

- Only plan dog-friendly activities.
- Keep an eye out for unusual behavior which could indicate stress or other discomforts.
- Keep your dog safely on a leash and pick up after them.
- Always carry a first aid kit.

CAMPING GEAR LIST

- Collapsible bowl & stainless steel bowl
- Dog food & treats
- Toys such as balls or chew toys
- Poop bag dispenser & poop bags
- Hands-free leash & harness
- ID Tags
- Cooling bed in summer, warm bed in winter
- Doggy sleeping bag
- LED collar OR clip-on light OR rechargeable necklace OR rechargeable vest
- Campsite dog hitching system
- Life vest for water activities
- Boots
- Dog pack
- Dog carrier
- Goggles
- Rain jacket
- Warm jacket
- First aid kit
- Tick removal kit
